MISSION UPDATE

- Celebrate Recovery and Prison Ministry: Mike Hall -

God is blessing Celebrate Recovery. The leadership team now numbers 14 and each Friday night meeting has anywhere from 40 to 70 regulars and visitors. Both the men's and women's step studies are progressing, with twenty folks attending. Both un-churched, and yes, even church people are finding new freedom in Christ as they work through the process to freedom on Thursday nights.

Because of the relationship with The HOPE Center, Celebrate Recovery is seeing new people coming through our doors. The leadership and members of CR are able to build relationships with individuals at The HOPE Center and then have a spiritual impact with them through CR. Shari Hall, Sheri and Darrell Anglen are now the directors of Hope Center. Rusty Olps and Jim Griffith are now on the board of directors, as are eleven others from Bridge Bible, First Presbyterian and the Church of the Nazarene. God is doing a work of creating more unity among churches in Moscow.

The prison ministry is also being sustained by the Lord. At Cottonwood, the program has been evolving due to program changes at the prison. Darrell Anglen continues to lead a group of men who go down there with him twice a week to preach the gospel and lead the men towards knowing Christ. There are step studies and a gospel presentation in the chapel. God has also opened a new door of opportunity at the Orofino prison. Jon Bateman and most recently, James McMurray are going down with Mike Hall on Wednesday nights. We are praying for 4 more men to come once a month so we can share the gospel amongst the main population as well as Givens Hall. Is God nudging you? It's a wonderful thing to see hope in a man's eyes when he comes to trust the Lord.
